84 students graduate from the Aga Khan Academy Hyderabad



The Academy celebrated its fifth graduation ceremony on Saturday 19th May 2018. The Class of 2018 concluded its International Baccalaureate journey with a formal evening ceremony attended by fellow students, Academy senior management, faculty and staff as well as parents, extended families and invited guests. Class of 2018 students admitted to some of the best universities worldwide



The number of Academy graduates has more than doubled since our first Diploma Programme cohort wrote their final IB examinations in 2014. More than 800 applications to universities in 12 countries were submitted by the 84 Class of 2018 students. So far there have been 25 acceptances to institutions appearing within the top 100 ShanghaiRanking (also known as the Academic Ranking of World Universities) for 2017. The average number of acceptances per student is 4.5. Overall, there have been over 100 scholarship offers amounting to \$5.3 million. # Aga Khan Academies partner with Ryerson University on training for innovation

Ryerson is providing 12 fellowships over three years for Academies students and faculty to attend the Ryerson DMZ Sandbox Basecamp summer programme, an intensive six-week programme for young entrepreneurs. The collaboration between the two institutions follows a visit by Mohamed Lachemi, president and vice-chancellor of Ryerson University, to the Aga Khan Academy Hyderabad in 2017. The first group of students from the Aga Khan Academies in Kenya and India will participate in the Basecamp programme this summer, accompanied by a teacher mentor.
