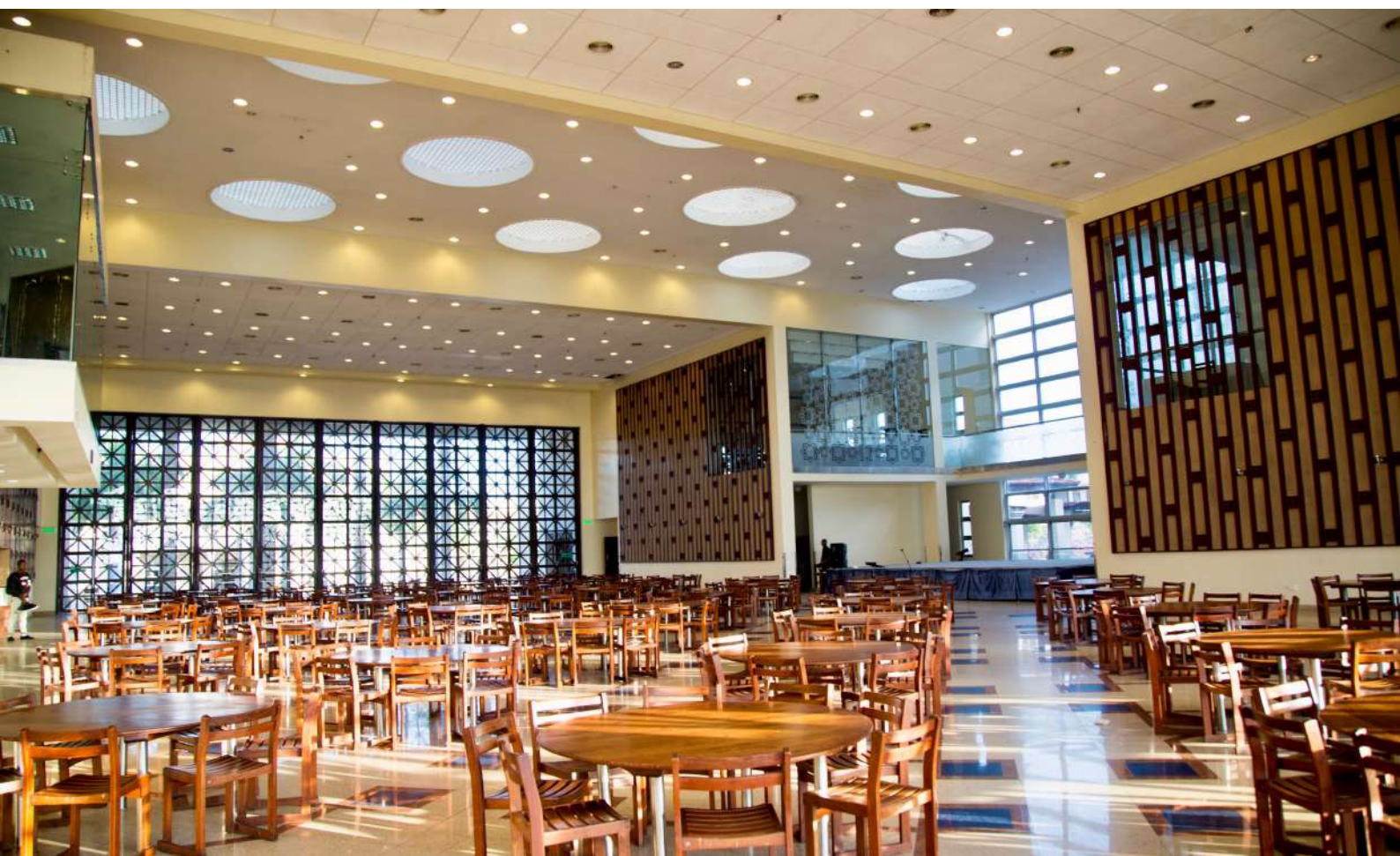
Workshop Leaders

For entry into Kenya (unless your country is exempt), you are required to create an account and apply for a visa on-line on the Kenya Government eCitizen platform <https://evisa.go.ke/evisa.html> Republic of Kenya Electronic Visa System. The visa cost is US\$ 50. If you require a visa letter, please do request for one by emailing ib.workshops@agakhanacademies.org and send a copy of your passport bio page.
